Without the kinship you have nothing because the kinship ties are strong and to be claimed as a relative and for whatever you, whatever relative you want to make, those are the strongest ties you can have to a person.

And to be, to address people with their kinship terms is much more powerful than anything else. And then we have specific roles that there's things that young girls should do and things that young boys should do and we explicitly teach that behavior.

It's taught in the homes too but maybe not all of them and then we teach it in schools too. We have pretty good cultural teachers that talk about women's roles and men's roles as part of our community.
